CHEVRONS

Originating around the 1600's as wood flooring, chevron as a design was inspired by the Romans. They made their brick roads directional creating an almost linear appearance which in later years crept into flooring design.

Installed in the 1600's in one of the origins most recognisable buildings of that period, the Palace of Versaille, chevron today is still noted for retaining its regal appearance and brings a modern classic French period look to interiors.

Our timeless $500 \times 90 \times 10/4$ mm chevrons are available from stock and finished to order.



Removing the soft grain enhances the texture of the timber.

Each piece of flooring is tumbled to achieve an authentic aged look to the edges and surface of the timber.



Bandsawn

Our bandsawn floors have traditional cut marks across the face of the floor and particularly suit retail and commercial projects.

Surface smoked – tones of medium to dark brown.

100% Fumed - tones of deep dark brown/black.

Our **fumed and smoked** colours are achieved through a process which reacts with the natural tannins in the oak and although we use controlled processes, the final colours are dictated by nature and not by using pigmented stains. As shown in Image 1 of our herringbone. Please be aware that when you buy smoked or fumed oak there will be a large variation in colour, this is the beauty of having these floors.

Torched Aged & Tumbled Light Smoked



Torched Bandsawn Light Smoked

Artistry of the flame. A clever process of our manufacturing which replicates the vintage planks of an aged wooden Lodge or grand chateau. Drafty air from below the floorboards and soot from open fires above the floor come together and oxidise on the edges of the plank creating a sootline edge. This creates definition and dimension on the plank edges over decades. Our experts masterfully recreate this look with a carbonising process just on the board edges. This process is repeated to achieve the required result.

As with smoking and fuming the torched process reacts in different ways with the 'nature that is wood'. Wider grain and knots will not burn as fast as the wood around them, especially if that surrounding grain is closer together. Whilst the effect will always show variation in finish, the position at which the torches are fixed in the machine is kept constant for consistency of the torching. This process is only available in our range of plank floors on the long edges, not the short ends.
